QUALITIES, SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE

- ii). You have the indefinable but undeniable gift to inspire young people to seek more of God in their lives.
- iii). You are a gifted communicator and have demonstrable experience in teaching young people from the bible in the power of the Holy Spirit.
- iv). You are a servant-hearted team-player, able and willing to work with all of us in our supportive staff team of 12.
- v). You have the interpersonal skills needed to quickly gain the confidence and respect of those in our church and its surrounding community.
- vi). You have a genuine love and appreciation of different cultures, with a readiness to learn from others from a wide range of backgrounds.
- vii). You (and any family you may have) will love belonging to the worshipping community that is All Saints Peckham.
- viii). You will be aware of safeguarding good practice and the ability to ensure that everything done is in accord with our existing child protection and vulnerable person policy.
- ix). Even if organisational skills are not your top gift, you will definitely need to demonstrate that you have some.

What is desirable is the following:

- i). You will have experience in strategic thinking, able to contribute to meetings and conversations where future strategy is the subject.
